Rules of Conduct

The Ellenville Public Library & Museum Board of Trustees invites the public to enjoy the library, its materials and its special services and programs.

For the comfort & safety of everyone, we ask your cooperation in observing the following rules:

- Misusing or moving library equipment.
- Leaving children under ten years old unattended in the library or on the library grounds.
- Loitering.
- Talking or laughing in a loud voice.
- Using obscene and/or abusive language.
- Placing feet on tables or chairs.
- Running, jumping, or horsing around.
- Eating or drinking.
- Playing audio and electronic equipment that is audible to others.
- No pets allowed.
- Blocking doorways or walkways with bicycles or strollers.
- Soliciting, selling, petitioning or gambling.
- Talking on mobile devices.
- Engaging in behavior which is inappropriate or disruptive to other library users.

The violation of any rule may lead to the suspension of library privileges or exclusion from the library premises.
